Overview of the Three-Level Distribution System

Primary Distribution Box (Main Distribution Board) Receives three-phase power, ground, and neutral from the transformer or site connection point. Secondary Distribution Box (Sub-Distribution Board) Connects to the primary box and distributes power to specific buildings, floors, or work zones. Supplies three-phase power to motors, heavy machinery, or intermediate loads. Includes general isolation, circuit breakers, fuses, and shunt protection. Designed with dual-door protection, plastic-sprayed exterior, and rainproof tops for safety and durability on construction sites. Provides intermediate-level protection, forming part of a layered safety system.

Tertiary Distribution Box (Final Distribution or Equipment Control Box) Connects to the secondary box and supplies single-phase 220–230V power to individual equipment or home systems. Implements “one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box” principle to ensure independent protection for each device. Includes leakage protection (RCDs) at both tertiary and secondary levels, forming a two-layer protection system. Can be fixed or portable, depending on site requirements, and is...
