A Layer 2 access switch operates at the data link layer, forwarding Ethernet frames within a LAN based on MAC addresses to efficiently connect devices. Overview A Layer 2 access switch is a network device that functions at the Data Link Layer (Layer 2) of the OSI model. Its primary role is to forward data frames between devices within the same local area network (LAN) using MAC addresses rather than IP addresses, which distinguishes it from Layer 3 switches that perform routing between networks. How It Works MAC Address Table: The switch maintains a table mapping each connected device's MAC address to the port it is connected to. When a frame arrives, the switch checks the destination MAC address and forwards it only to the corresponding port, reducing unnecessary traffic. Learning Process: If the switch receives a frame from an unknown source, it records the source MAC address and port in its table. Unknown destination addresses are treated as broadcasts and sent to all ports except the incoming one. Collision Domains: Each port on a Layer 2 switch acts as its own collision domain, minimizing collisions and improving network efficiency. Features VLAN Support: Layer 2 switches can segment a network into Virtual LANs (VLANs), allowing logical separation of devices without changing physical connections. Low Latency: They operate near wire speed, providing fast frame forwarding with minimal delay. Broadcast Domains: All devices connected to a Layer 2 switch share the same broadcast domain, meaning broadcast traffic is forwarded to all ports. Use Cases Access Layer Deployment: Layer 2 switches are commonly used at the access layer of a network to connect end devices like computers, printers, and IP phones. LAN Traffic Management: They efficiently manage local traffic, reduce congestion, and improve data flow within a single network segment. Cost-Effective Networking: Layer 2 switches are generally less expensive than Layer 3 switches and are ideal for simple LANs without inter-network routing requirements. Comparison...
