

Add a ground wire to the home's electrical distribution box

Step 5: Connect the Ground Wire Drill or use a knock-out hole in the panel to route the wire. Attach the wire to the ground rod using a clamp or toothed connector. Inside the panel, connect the wire to the grounding bar using a screw terminal. Ensure a tight, secure connection with a clockwise loop around the screw for maximum metal-to-metal contact.

Step 6: Verify and Finish Replace the panel cover. Turn the main breaker back on. Test the grounding connection using a multimeter or plug-in tester to confirm continuity and proper grounding.

Additional Tips Run the ground wire parallel to hot and neutral wires but avoid sharp bends. If your home has metal plumbing, it can sometimes serve as a supplemental grounding path, but the primary connection should always be to a proper grounding electrode. Ensure compliance with National...
