Avoid bending fiber cables beyond manufacturer recommendations to prevent attenuation or microfractures. Multimode fiber optic switches can handle multiple input and output ports, supporting simplex or duplex connections, and may use MEMS or liquid crystal technology for fast, reliable switching.
5. Activation and Testing: After adding the switch and configuring zones, commit the zone set to enforce the new configuration across the fabric. Test connectivity between initiators and targets to ensure proper communication and ve...
