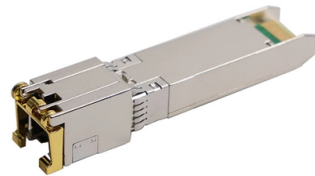

Key Factors for Compatibility

- Form Factor and Data Rate:** Ensure the module matches the port type on your switch or router (e.g., SFP, SFP+, SFP28, QSFP). SFP+ ports are often backward-compatible with 1G SFP modules, but the speed will downgrade to 1G if used.
- Wavelength and Fiber Type:** Both ends of a fiber link must use the same wavelength (e.g., 850nm, 1310nm) and fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) to avoid signal loss or degradation.
- Duplex Mode:** Full-duplex modules must be paired with full-duplex counterparts; mixing with half-duplex modules will prevent proper transmission.
- Vendor and Firmware Compatibility:** Some OEMs, like Cisco or Juniper, may lock firmware to their branded transceivers. Using tested third-party modules from vendors like Link-PP or ESOPTIC ensures plug-and-play operation and avoids firmware conflicts.
- Advanced Features:** Modules with DDM (Digital Diagnostic Monitoring), FEC (Forward Error Correction), and low-power designs improve reliability and performance, especially in high-speed or dense deployments.
