Installation Considerations Support arms must be installed at regular intervals according to the tray manufacturer's specifications to safely carry the weight of cables and any additional imposed loads. They should be made from high-quality materials such as steel or stainless steel, often with galvanization or other corrosion-resistant coatings for durability. Proper attachment to the structural frame is critical, using appropriate anchors or bolts (e.g., M10, M12, M16) depending on the support type and load requirements. Support arms are not intended for human support; they are strictly for cable management and must be used in conjunction with compatible cable trays or ladders.
