For multimode fiber, the loss is about 3 dB per km for 850 nm sources, 1 dB per km for 1300 nm. 5 dB/km max per EIA/TIA 568) This roughly translates into a loss of 0. 1 dB per 300 feet (100 m) for 1300 nm.
