Finishing: After welding, edges are deburred, and surfaces may be coated or polished to prevent corrosion and ensure safe cable handling (). Installation Considerations Ensure elbows maintain continuous support for cables and do not exceed the recommended bend radius. Use ventilated or solid-bottom elbows depending on heat dissipation and electromagnetic interference requirements ().
