- Split-load configuration:** Uses multiple RCDs to separate circuits, e.g., upstairs and downstairs lighting, ensuring that a fault in one area does not cut power to the entire house.
- Three-phase wiring:** Rare in homes but used in large buildings or for heavy appliances. It involves three hot wires (L1, L2, L3) and requires careful load balancing.

Wiring Practices

- Wire sizing:** 14-gauge wire is common for 15A circuits (lighting), 12-gauge for 20A circuits (outlets).
- Grounding:** All metal boxes and circuits must be grounded; plastic boxes may not require grounding.
- Color coding:** Live wires are typically black or red, neutral is white, and grounding is green or bare copper.
