Main Power Connection: Connect the incoming live (phase) wire to the main terminal or main breaker. Connect the neutral and ground wires to their respective busbars.

Circuit Breaker Installation: Insert the appropriate circuit breakers for each branch circuit into the designated slots in the distribution box.

Branch Wiring: Connect each branch wire to its corresponding breaker. Ensure:

- Live wires go to the breaker terminals.
- Neutral wires connect to the neutral busbar.
- Ground wires connect to the grounding busbar.

Color coding is followed (e.g., brown/red for live, blue for neutral, green/yellow for ground).

Wire Management: Route wires neatly inside the enclosure, using cable ties or clips to prevent tangling and allow proper heat dissipation.

Labeling: Clearly label each branch circuit for identification and safety.
