Ensure trays are level and aligned, and handle PVC trays carefully to avoid cracks or deformation. For long runs, consider using rollers to lay cables smoothly.

Cable Laying and Organization Lay cables neatly inside the tray, using ties or straps to separate by voltage and function. Leave slack for expansion or future adjustments. Integrated bottom guides in PVC trays allow quick accessory installation without additional fixing.

Grounding and Safety While PVC trays are non-conductive, ensure proper grounding for any metallic components or connections to comply with NEC and local standards. Maintain clearances of at least 12 inches above trays for safe access and maintenance.

Labeling and Documentation Label all cables clearly and maintain an updated wiring diagram.
