Practical Considerations Compatibility: Ensure the climbing elbow matches the width and height of the existing tray system. Cable Fill and Bend Radius: Select an elbow radius that prevents excessive bending of cables, especially for fiber optic or large power cables. Installation: Climbing elbows can be used in combination with straight sections, tees, and crosses to create complex vertical and horizontal routing. Standards Compliance: Most elbows are designed to meet CSA, UL, NEC, and IEC standards for cable management . By loading this tray more heavily, the designer must be careful not to exceed the total cable capacity as outlined in the Canadian Electrical Code (See following section on ladder tray sizing).
