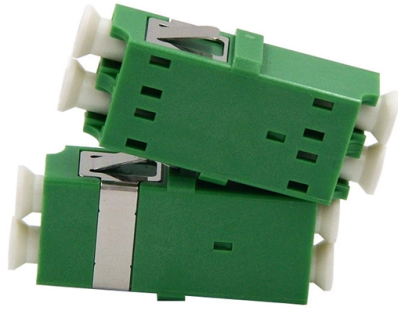

- Length Cutting:** Trays are cut to standard or customized lengths, commonly 2m, 3m, or 6m.
- Surface Treatment:** Trays undergo galvanization, powder coating, or painting to enhance corrosion resistance and durability.
- Automatic Stacking and Packaging:** Finished trays are stacked and p...
