Types of Cable Entry Systems

Cable entry systems allow electrical cables to be introduced into a distribution box safely. Common types include:

- Flameproof Ex d cable entries:** These are used in hazardous areas to prevent explosions. They consist of a threaded metal sleeve that anchors and encapsulates the sheathed cable, allowing individual cores to be connected inside the enclosure. The engaged thread length must comply with DIN EN 60079-0 and DIN EN 60079-1 standards.
- Grommet-based cable entry frames:** These allow routing of preassembled cables at 90° angles, provide IP66 sealing, and accommodate cables with or without connectors. Split or single-row frames are available for different cable diameters, ensuring flexibility in industrial setups.
- Cord grips and conduit entries:** These are used to secure cables and prevent water ingress, especially in outdoor or wash-down environments. Properly sealed cord grips exclude moisture and maintain the integrity of the enclosure.

Positioning and Direction

Bottom entry is preferred: Bringing cables in through the bottom of the box reduces the risk of water ingress and moisture accumulation.

Cable direction matters: For certain switchgear, such as HVL/cc, cables must enter and exit in opposite directions to avoid interference and ensure proper routing. Top entries should be grouped together, and bottom entries should be grouped together to simplify transitions.

Rear extensions: If additional depth is needed for cable bends, standard rear extensions (16.75", 24", 30") can be used to accommodate proper routing.

Installation Best Practices

- Sealing and IP rating:** Ensure the cable entry system maintains the enclosure's IP or NEMA rating to protect against dust and water.
- Grounding:** All cables should include proper earth leads, typically green-yellow, and be securely connected.
- Cable management:** Maintain neat routing inside the box, avoid sharp bends, and ensure sufficient length...
