These systems are usually brand-specific and may have higher upfront costs.
- 3. Junction and Angle Connections** L, T, or cross-shaped plates are used to join tray sections at angles or junctions, allowing cables to route around corners or splits. These fittings ensure proper alignment and maintain structural integrity.

**Installation and Support Guidelines**

**Route Planning:** Mark the cable tray path considering clearance, load capacity, and cable separation requirements before installation.

**Support Spacing:** Cable trays should be supported at intervals of 1.5–3 meters for straight runs, with additional supports near bends, elbows, or junctions.

**Expansion Fittings:** Use expansion connectors at building expansion joints or long outdoor runs to accommodate thermal expansion and prevent stress on the tray.

**Grounding and Bonding:** Install bonding jumpers at each expansion joint and ground trays at least every 15 meters to maintain electrical continuity and safety.

**Cable Handling Within the Tray** Lay cables neatly, using cable ties or straps to separate by voltage and function. Maintain minimum bend radius for cables exiting the tray to prevent dama...
