- Bolted Connections:** Standard fasteners used with splice plates or other fittings. Reliable and removable for future adjustments ().
- Quick Connect Systems:** Snap, slide, or twist systems that require minimal tools. Ideal for large projects where installation speed is critical, though often brand-specific ().
- Clamps and Fish Plates:** Used for angled connections (L, T, or cross-shaped) to route cables around corners or junctions ().
- Welding:** Provides permanent, high-strength connections, typically used in heavy-duty or industrial applications ().

Installation Tips

- Plan the Route:** Mark tray paths considering clearance, load, and cable separation ().
- Select Tray Type:** Ladder, perforated, or solid-bottom trays depending on airflow, load, and environment ().
- Support Spacing:** Typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart depending on tray type and load ().
- Alignment and Leveling:** Ensure trays are straight and level before securing connections ().
- Grounding and Bonding:** Maintain electrical continuity across tray sections using proper bonding jumpers ().
- Documentation:** Label cables and maintain wiring maps for future maintenance ().
