Clearances: Maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above trays for installation and maintenance access (). Fill Limits: Do not exceed 40% of tray cross-sectional area for power cables and 50% for control cables (). Separation: Keep high-power and low-power cables apart to reduce EMI (). Support and Mounting Support spacing: Typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart depending on tray type and load (). Center-hung or wall-mounted supports: Ensure trays are level and secure to prevent sagging (). Load capacity: Verify that each hanger can support the maximum cable weight, usually 700–750 lbs per support (). Grounding and Bonding Metallic trays can serve as an equipment grounding conductor (EGC) if installed according to NEC requirements ().
