Horizontal and vertical runs should be coordinated to avoid clashes with other services, and sufficient space must be provided for cable pulling and future maintenance . Cable and Tray Considerations Only use conductors rated for open-air environments, such as Tray Rated (Type TC) or Metal-Clad (Type MC) cables . High-power and low-power cables must be separated to prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI), . Single conductor cables smaller than 1/0 AWG are generally not allowed, except under specific industrial conditions . For outdoor or sunlight-exposed areas, use sunlight-resistant cables and expansion splice plates to accommodate thermal expansion . Material and Design Select tray material based on environmental conditions and load requirements: aluminum, steel, or FRP . Common designs include ladder, solid-bottom, and ventilated trough trays, each suited for specific needs like heat dissipation, cable support, or EMI shielding . Ladder trays are preferred in industrial environments for cooling heavy power cables. Support and Installation Supports should be spaced 1.5 to 3 meters apart, depending on tray type and load .
