Proper spacing between power and signal cables is essential to prevent interference and maintain performance (ToolGrit) . Material Considerations: Cable trays are made from steel, aluminum, or other alloys, with finishes like galvanization or powder coating to resist corrosion. Material choice can affect structural strength and allowable load (ABB Technical Guide) . Pipe Fittings Quota For conduits and pipe fittings, the quota is determined by: Conduit Fill: The total cross-sectional area of cables should not exceed 40% of the conduit's internal area for a single conduit, and 31% for multiple conduits, according to standard electrical codes. Fitting Allowance: Bends, elbows, and junction boxes reduce effective fill capacity. Each fitting has a derating factor that must be considered in design. Spacing and Support: Proper support intervals and spacing prevent sagging and mechanical stress on cables or pipes (Eaton Cable Tray Resources) .
