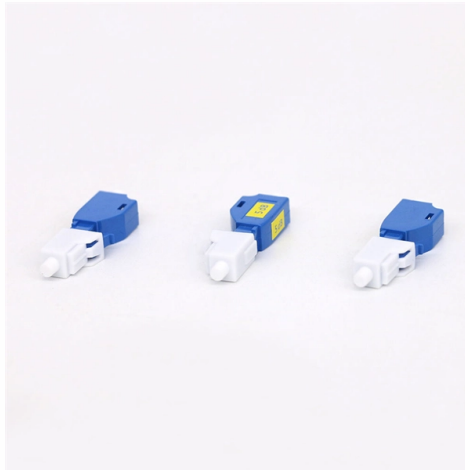


Cable tray replacement construction
