

Cable tray right angle bend construction

3. Compound Bends: Combine horizontal and vertical changes, requiring careful calculation of offset distances to maintain smooth cable flow ().

Construction Methods

Pre-Fabricated Fittings: Ladder, perforated, and wire mesh trays often come with 90° bend fittings. These fittings are designed to maintain the minimum bending radius required for the cables, preventing damage and easing cable pulling ().

On-Site Fabrication: Wire mesh trays can be bent live at the project using tools like a bolt cutter or bending jigs. Protective measures, such as rubber caps or zinc-coated edges, prevent cable abrasion at cut or bent ends (). Measure the straight section length along the tray to mark bending points accurately, ensuring the bend aligns with the intended path ().

Key Considerations

Bend Radius: Always respect the cable manufacturer's minimum bend radius to avoid insulation damage. Larger, heavier, or high-voltage cables require gentler bends (15°–22.5°) while 30°–45° bends are common for standard installations ().

Offset Calculation: For compound bends, calculate the true offset using trigonometry or a cable tray offset calculator to ensure proper alignment and avoid interference with other structures ().

Support and Load: Ensure the tray is adequately supported before and after the bend to prevent sagging or stress on the cables ().

Material and Finish: Use galvanized or stainless steel for industrial applications to resist corrosion, and consider modular systems for easy installation and future modifications ().
