- Reductions and End Closures:** Adjust tray width or terminate runs safely.

These fittings ensure that cables maintain a minimum bend radius, preventing damage to sensitive cables like fiber optics or coaxial lines.

Support Systems

Proper support is critical for multi-slope trays:

- Suspended Supports:** Ceiling-mounted brackets or rods that hold trays at varying heights.
- Wall Brackets:** Support trays along walls or vertical surfaces.
- Center Supports:** Used for long spans to prevent sagging and maintain slope integrity.

Support spacing depends on tray type, material, and cable load. Ladder trays typically require supports every 1.5–3 meters, while solid-bottom trays may n...
