DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.

On a roll!

Use cable guides and rollers to prevent the cable dragging on the trench or rack bottom. Leading roller (driver) shall be used to support the cable over the entire drum width immediately before being fed
