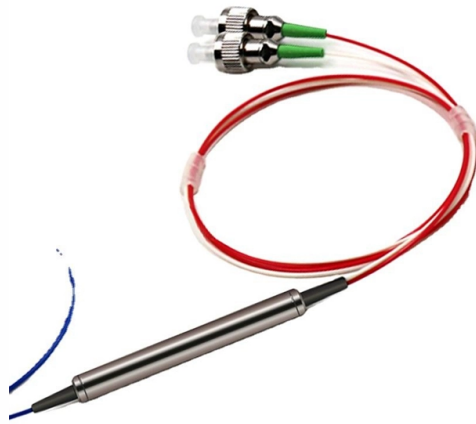


Calculation Rules for Laying Optical Cables in Ducts



Overview

Key recommendations include compliance with ITU-T G. 65x series and IEC 60794-3-11 standards, performance criteria for tests, and considerations for cable design and installation. The document details optical fiber characteristics such as attenuation, microbending, macrobending. Corning Optical Communications cable specification sheets are available which list the maximum tensile load for various cable types. The maximum pulling tension for stranded loose tube cable and ribbon cable is 600 lbf (2,700 Newtons).
