

# Can I replace the router with a fiber optic cable from a telecom company

- Configure Settings:** Access the router's admin panel to update VLAN, DHCP, or PPPoE settings if required by your ISP.
- Test Connection:** Run speed tests to confirm you are achieving the expected fiber speeds.
