Some ISPs provide combo units that integrate the ONT and router into a single device, simplifying setup and reducing the number of devices needed. However, even in this case, the router functionality is still present—it is not eliminated by the fiber cable itself.

Why Fiber Doesn't Replace the Router Fiber optic cables only handle the transport of data from the ISP to your home. They do not manage local network traffic, Wi-Fi distribution, or device connectivity. Without a router or gateway, you would have a high-speed internet signal at the ONT, but no way to share it with multiple devices or create a secure home network.
