- Power and Test:** Power on the switch and verify link lights or status indicators to confirm a successful connection. Clean connectors to prevent signal loss due to dust or debris.

- Bandwidth Matching:** Select SFP modules that match the switch's port speed and network requirements (1G, 10G, or higher).
