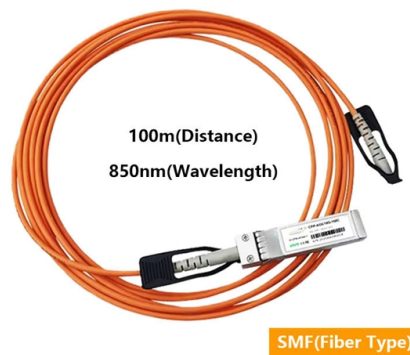


Can the optical module be plugged into the power port

Compatibility Considerations

Physical Interface: Optical modules use fiber connectors, while electrical/power modules use copper RJ45 connectors. These are not physically compatible.

Signal Type: Optical modules transmit light-based signals, whereas electrical modules transmit electrical signals. Direct connection would not allow proper signal conversion.

Functional Purpose: Optical modules are for high-speed fiber communication, while power modules are for electrical transmission and sometimes PoE. They serve different roles in a network.
