Using high-quality fusion splicing equipment, inspecting connectors under a microscope, and protecting splices in sealed enclosures help prevent these failures.

Installation and Handling Errors Improper installation, such as tight loops, kinks, or exceeding bend radius, can create persistent blockages. Using bend-insensitive fibers, cable management hardware, and adhering to manufacturer guidelines reduces the risk of signal loss.
