- Mombasa-Nairobi Standard Gauge Railway:** Funded by China, this railway has reduced travel time from 10 hours to four, boosting commerce and regional connectivity.
- Lamu Port in Kenya:** Part of Kenya's Vision 2030, this port project has created thousands of jobs and trained local engineers and technicians, enhancing trade capacity.
- De Aar Wind Farm in South Africa:** A clean energy project supplying 760 million kWh annually, supporting Africa's green transition.

In total, Chinese companies have helped build or upgrade over 10,000 km of railways, nearly 100,000 km of highways, roughly 1,000 bridges, and almost 100 ports across Africa.
