Individual Circuit Breakers (MCBs): Protect each branch circuit by interrupting current flow in case of overload or short circuit. Residual Current Devices (RCDs): Detect leakage currents and cut off power to prevent electric shocks. Neutral and Earth Busbars: Provide safe connections for neutral and grounding wires, ensuring safety and proper system operation.
