- 4. Fiber Cable Installation**Fiber cables are installed either aerially or underground:
 - Aerial Installation:** Cables are strung between utility poles using pulleys and tensioners, secured with clamps and spacers. This method is faster and less disruptive, suitable for suburban or rural areas.
 - Underground Installation:** Cables are pulled through conduits or ducts beneath streets or sidewalks. Micro-trenching is a minimally invasive technique that cuts narrow trenches for fiber, reducing traffic disruption and cost.
