Core Components

- IT Cabinets / Racks** These house servers, storage devices, and networking equipment. Micro-modules typically use a small number of racks arranged back-to-back or face-to-face, often with closed hot or cold aisles to optimize airflow and isolate hot and cold air streams .

- Cooling Subsystem**
 - Rack Cooling Units / Air Conditioning Terminals:** Maintain optimal temperature and humidity within the module .
 - Closed Aisle Systems:** Cold or hot aisles are sealed to prevent mixing of airflows, improving cooling efficiency and reducing energy consumption .
 - EC Fans:** High-performance fans with electronic commutation for precise airflow control .
- Cabling and Networking**
 - Structured Cabling:** Pre-integrated cabling for network and power connections.
 - Networking Equipment:** Switches, routers, and other devices to manage data traffic within the module .
- Monitoring and Management Systems**
 - Sensors and Software:** Monitor voltage, current, power usage, temperature, humidity, and PUE (Power Usage Effectiveness), .
 - Remote Monitoring:** Provides real-time visibility and historical data for operational management .
 - Independent Control Systems:** Each micro-module operates autonomously, with data upload capabilities to higher-tier monitoring systems .
