

Configuration and Management of Aggregation Switches



AI Overview

Aggregation switches are configured to combine multiple physical ports, stack devices, and manage VLANs and routing to ensure high availability, redundancy, and optimized bandwidth. Port Aggregation Setup Port aggregation allows multiple physical ports to function as a single logical link, providing load balancing and redundancy. Key steps include: Ensure consistent port attributes across all aggregated ports: speed, duplex (full duplex only), link type (trunk, hybrid, or access), VLANs, and STP settings (enable/disable, priority, cost) (Cisco). Choose aggregation mode: ON mode: Static aggregation, no LACP required, up to 8 ports. Active mode: Dynamic aggregation, LACP required, initiates negotiation, up to 12 ports (8 active, 4 backup). Passive mode: Dynamic aggregation, LACP required, responds to negotiation, same port limits as active mode. Synchronization occurs automatically if port attributes are modified within the aggregation group. Stacking Aggregation Switches Stacking increases interface density and redundancy: Ensure all switches are factory default and running compatible firmware (e.g., AOS-CX 10.7+ for Aruba). Use reserved auto-stacking ports and connect switches in a ring topology. Designate a conductor switch by pressing the mode button until the LED displays STK; subsequent members join the stack sequentially. Verify stack status via LED indicators: flashing green (conductor), flashing orange (joining/rebooting), solid green (operational). VLAN and Interface Configuration Configure uplink and downlink Eth-Trunk interfaces for Layer 2/3 connectivity. Assign VLANs to interfaces and configure IP addresses and routes for Layer 3 interfaces to ensure network connectivity. Enable DHCP on aggregation switches to assign IP addresses to wired and wireless clients and APs. Configure VRRP and HSB on ACs if using a standalone AC deployment. Redundancy...
