Step 4: Power On and Verify Once connected, power on the router (and ONT if applicable). Check the indicator LEDs next to the port: a steady or blinking light usually confirms an active connection. On connected devices, the network icon should switch from WiFi to a wired connection symbol.

Step 5: Troubleshooting If the connection fails, try reinserting the cable or flipping the connector if it doesn't slide in smoothly. For fiber connections, clean the connector with a fiber cleaning tool if necessary. Ensure the router and ONT are compatible and configured correctly, including any required Quality of Service (QoS) or network settings.
