- Fiber Channel Switches:** Switches like the Cisco MDS 9148T or IBM SAN24B-7 provide multiple FC ports (ranging from 8 to 48 or more) with speeds from 8G to 64G FC, supporting features like zoning, link encryption, and NVMe over FC.
- Fiber Optic Cabling:** Duplex LC fiber patch cords connect SFP modules on servers, switches, and storage arrays. Proper labeling, bend radius, and cable management are essential to prevent damage and maintain signal integrity.

Configuration and Connectivity

- Install SFP Modules:** Insert FC SFPs into the HBA on the server, the switch ports, and the storage array ports.
- Connect Fiber Cables:** Use duplex LC fiber optic cables to link the server HBA to the switch and the switch to the storage array. Ensure the correct type of fiber (OM3 multimode or OS2 single-mode) based on distance requirements.
- Zoning and Fabric Setup:** Configure the switch to define which servers can access which storage ports, ensuring security and traffic isolation.
