Clean the Fiber: Wipe the exposed fiber with alcohol or specialized cleaning rods to remove dust, oil, or residue.

Cleaving: Use a fiber cleaver to make a precise, flat cut at the fiber end, which is critical for optimal light transmission.

Insert into Connector: For pre-polished connectors, align the cleaved fiber with the connector core and insert it carefully. For field-installable connectors, secure the fiber using a crimping tool or adhesive as required.

Test the Connection: Use a visual fault locator (VFL) or optical power meter to verify alignment and minimal signal loss.

Connecting Using Fusion Splicing

Prepare Fiber Ends: Strip and clean both fiber ends as above.

Align Fibers: Place the fibers in a fusion splicer, which aligns them precisely.

Fuse the Fibers: The splicer melts the fiber ends together, creating a permanent, low-loss connection.

Protect the Splice: Use a protective sleeve or heat-shrink tubing to safeguard the joint from mechanical stress.

Test the Splice: Verify the connection quality with an optical time-domain reflectometer (OTDR) or power meter.
