Fiber Optic Cable: Typically duplex LC connectors for send/receive signals; pre-terminated cables simplify installation. Configuration: The optical port may need to be set as a WAN port on the switch or router interface to route internet traffic correctly. Steps to Enable Internet Access Verify Compatibility: Ensure the SFP module matches the switch port and fiber type. Clean and Inspect: Fiber connectors must be free of dust or debris to prevent signal loss. Insert the Module: Carefully insert the SFP/SFP+ module into the optical port. Connect Fiber Cable: Attach the fiber cable, ensuring proper alignment of send and receive strands. Configure the Port: Set the optical port as a WAN or uplink port in the switch or router settings to enable internet access.
