A distribution box (also called a distribution board, consumer unit, or fuse board) is the central hub for electrical power in a home. The distribution box contains:

- Main switch or double-pole MCB:** Controls the overall power supply to the house.
- Circuit breakers or fuses:** Protect individual circuits from overloads or short circuits.
- Residual Current Devices (RCDs):** Provide additional safety by detecting leakage currents and preventing electric shocks.
- Busbars and terminals:** Connect live (phase), neutral, and earth wires to the respective circuits ().

Wiring to Appliance Circuits

Electricity flows from the distribution box to appliance circuits via branch circuits, which are wired in parallel. This ensures each appliance receives the full supply voltage and can operate independently ().

The connection process involves:

- Live wire (phase):** Carries current from the distribution box to the appliance.
- Neutral wire:** Returns current from the appliance back to the distribution box.
- Earth wire:** Provides a safe path for leakage currents to prevent electric shock ().

Each appliance or group of appliances is connected to a dedicated circuit breaker in the distribution box. For high-power appliances like air conditioners or ovens, dedicated circuits with appropriately rated wires and breakers are used to handle the load safely ().
