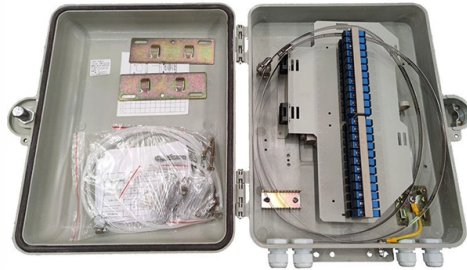

Plating and Contact Integration While the cap itself is plastic, the metal contacts or pins that fit inside are produced separately through stamping and electroplating. Contacts are coated with metals like gold or nickel to improve conductivity and prevent corrosion. These contacts are then inserted into the molded cap during assembly.

Assembly Automated systems insert the plated contacts into the connector cap. This can be done one pin at a time or using combined insertion for multiple pins simultaneously. Precision is critical to ensure proper alignment and spacing between...
