Core Switch Pool in Software Systems In software systems like FreeSWITCH, a core memory pool is a pre-allocated block of memory used to manage session-specific or permanent allocations efficiently. Memory pools reduce fragmentation and improve performance by reusing memory for multiple sessions. Key operations include: Session allocation: Memory allocated for the lifetime of a session. Permanent allocation: Memory that persists for the lifetime of the application. Pool management: Pools can be created, cleared, or destroyed, and a background thread may recycle unused pools to optimize memory usage. Thread safety: Mutexes and locks ensure safe concurrent access to the pool. This approach allows high-performance applications to handle thousands of concurrent sessions without frequent system-level memory allocation calls.
