Labor and Installation: Labor hours depend on project complexity. Small runs (500 ft) may require 25–40 hours, while larger campus or city-wide projects (5,000 ft) can require 150–260 hours. Labor costs are influenced by urban, suburban, or rural settings, with urban areas typically incurring higher permit and right-of-way fees (LatestCost).

Permits and Restoration: Urban deployments often require traffic control, street restoration, and permits, which can increase costs by 10–30% compared to rural areas. Rural projects may have lower labor costs but longer travel times (LatestCost).
