Tray Type and Bottom Design: Ladder trays have open rungs for maximum ventilation and heat dissipation. Perforated or trough trays provide continuous support with ventilation holes. Channel trays offer protection for smaller instrumentation cables and can be solid or ventilated.

Cable Fill and Electrical Considerations: Cable fill is calculated based on the outside diameter of cables, not the copper cross-section. Standards typically limit tray fill to a percentage of the usable area (commonly 40%) to prevent overheating and maintain safety.

Rung Spacing: For ladder trays, rung spacing is typically 150–230 mm (6–9 inches) to support cables while allowing airflow and minimizing sag.
