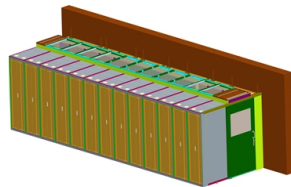


Cuba Optical Cable Landing Station

The ALBA-1 cable system is currently the only one commercial international cable system connecting Cuba to the world. Besides, there are GTMO-1 and GTMO-PR submarine cable systems landing at U. Naval Station Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, not available for commercial use. The Americas Region Caribbean Optical -Ring System (ARCOS-1) is a 8,700 km submarine cable system connecting 24 landing points in 15 countries, including the United States, the Bahamas, the Turks and Caicos Islands, the Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico, Curacao, Venezuela, Colombia, Panama, Costa.
