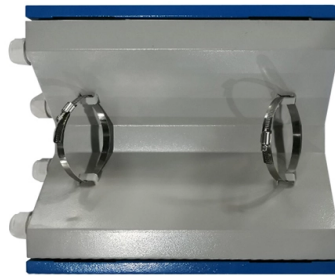


Delayed Connection Method for Distribution Box

- Wiring Configuration:**
 - Phase (Live) Line:** Connect the incoming live wire to the timer input, then from the timer output to the MCB or load.
 - Neutral Line:** Connect directly to the neutral busbar, unless using a 2P breaker that requires both live and neutral to pass through the timer.
 - Protective Earth (PE):** Ensure the PE wire is connected to the ground busbar for safety.
- Sequential Startup:** Multiple circuits can be connected to separate timers or a multi-channel delay relay to stagger their activation. This prevents simultaneous inrush currents and reduces the risk of tripping the main breaker.
