Optional detailed diagnostics: Some switches support Digital Optical Monitoring (DOM/DDM), which provides real-time monitoring of optical power and environmental parameters. Using Web-Based Interface (WBI) or GUI On Dell PowerConnect switches, you can navigate to System → Diagnostics → Optical Transceiver Diagnostics to read SFP register values and check if the optical port is functioning correctly. Minor fluctuations in readings are normal; consistent values within acceptable ranges indicate a healthy optical link. Key Parameters to Monitor Link Status: UP indicates normal operation. TX/RX Power: Ensure values are within the recommended thresholds. Temperature and Voltage: Check for overheating or abnormal voltage. LOS (Loss of Signal): Indicates fiber or transceiver issues. Transceiver Type and Compatibility: Confirm the SFP module matches the switch specifications to avoid link flapping or incompatibility. By following these steps, you can effectively monitor, tr...
