

Direct connection between optical module and optical transceiver

Insert the fiber: Gently insert the fiber connector into the optical module until it clicks or seats firmly. Avoid bending or tightly bundling the fiber, as this can degrade signal quality.

Replace dust caps when disconnected: If the fiber is removed for maintenance, immediately replace the dust cap to protect the module.
