Use Proper Connectors if Needed For multiple ground wires, twist-on wire connectors (wire nuts) or crimp connectors can be used to join wires before connecting to the PE bar. Listed pressure connectors or tool-applied crimps are recommended for reliable bonding.

Verify Continuity and Safety Ensure that the grounding path is continuous and that all metal parts of the box and connected devices are properly bonded. For metal boxes, direct metal-to-metal contact or a listed grounding clip can also maintain continuity.

Label and Inspect Clearly mark the grounding connections for future inspection and maintenance. Regularly check that screws remain tight and that wires are not dam...
