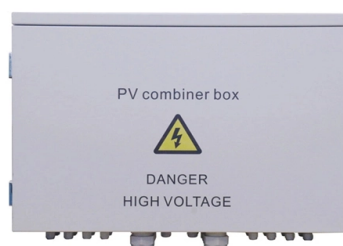


Distribution boxes and switch boxes should have

Switch boxes and distribution boxes must be properly installed, grounded, insulated, accessible, and protected to ensure safe and efficient electrical distribution. The protective neutral line should be connected through a terminal block. Insulation: Connecting wires must be insulated, joints secure, and no live parts exposed. The working neutral wire and protective ground wire must not be mixed. Environmental Protection: Boxes must be rain-proof, dust-proof, and smash-proof to prevent hazards.
