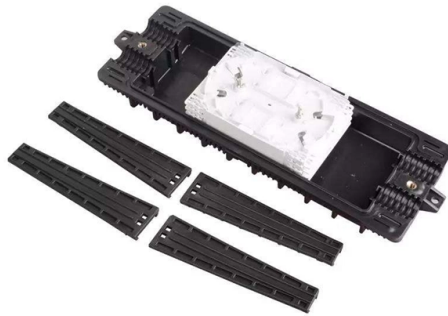


Do I need to configure a 50Mbps fiber optic router

Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.1.1 or as specified in the manual). Enter your ISP-provided credentials (username and password) in the WAN/Internet settings. Update the router firmware to the latest version for security and performance. Set a strong Wi-Fi password and customize your network name (SSID) for easy identification. Optionally, configure QoS (Quality of Service) to prioritize bandwidth for critical applications like streaming or gaming.

Step 5: Optimize Your Network

- Router placement:** Position centrally to maximize Wi-Fi coverage.
- Wired connections:** Use Ethernet for devices requiring stable speeds, especially for 50Mbps usage.
- Test speed:** Use online speed tests to ensure you are achieving close to 50Mbps.
- Security:** Enable WPA3 or WPA2 encryption and disable WPS if not needed.
